

Workshop location:

This workshop is being held in Douglas Mehrens' private [studio](#) in Cerrillos, NM, approximately 30 miles south of Santa Fe. The studio, located in the former "EAI Pyramid Gallery" is an architect-designed, light-filled space that is a pleasure to work in. The property and surrounding area are beautiful and provide an ideal setting for taking the kinds of photos you will be shooting as part of this workshop.

For those workshop registrants who are traveling from outside of NM, (or do not have a car):

It is necessary to have a car to access this workshop. We are currently working on options to make this venue more accessible for those who didn't plan to rent a car to attend the Conference/workshops, such as ride-sharing. We will work out some alternative transportation options and will contact registrants with whatever options we've come up with prior to the workshop start date.
